Subject: Ineligible Categories and Program Status Codes

To: All Statewide County MATP Program Offices

Purpose:

The Medical Assistance Transportation Program is reminding all Counties that after recipient Medicaid eligibility is checked in the Eligibility Verification System (EVS), the next step is to ensure the recipient's Category of Medical Assistance and Program Status Codes are valid for MATP services using the MATP Eligibility Guide. The guide has been distributed to all program offices and is also available on the MATP Internet Website.

Background:

Many counties are providing trips to recipients who are eligible for Medicaid, but are not eligible for MATP services. These records are failing the Department's validation system and are being identified as a failed record. County offices are finding out later that they had provided a trip to a non-eligible consumer.

Discussion:

The Department has always maintained a list of eligible and ineligible Category and Program Status Codes. This document can be found at:

Because the Department of Public Welfare makes programmatic changes time to time which affect the eligibility of certain categories and status codes, this document is always updated when these changes occur. It is important that County program offices have the most current list; county offices are always notified by the MATP office directly by email when a change on the eligibility list occurs.

Below is a list of all category and program status codes that are ineligible for MATP. This list current as of October, 2007; it is always subject to change.
